4. In 2006, which state, that is home to one of the United States Mint facilities, will celebrate the release of it's own quarter design?
5. The "Keystone State," which is home to the first United States Mint, celebrated the release of its quarter in what year?
6. The state that sees the nation's first light celebrates the release of their quarter reverse in which year?
7. Which state, whose quarter highlights a special race, joined the Union in 1792?
8. Which state, whose quarter reverse was first seen in 2001, is home to the United States Military Academy? (Here's some help: in 2002 the U.S. Mint made a commemorative coin to celebrate this academy.)
9. The symbol featured on which state's quarter reverse represents men who fought in the American Revolution?
10. A man pictures on which state's quarter reverse is also pictured on the quarter's obverse?
