### LIBERTY AWAKENED

## Emerging Liberty Dime

Marking the founding era of American history, Liberty returns to circulating coinage for the first time in decades. The design draws from early U.S. coins, where Liberty, and her cap, stood as enduring symbols of independence and self-government.



### LIBERTY IMAGINED

## Mayflower Compact Quarter

Before the Nation's founding, the Mayflower Compact established an early expression of the belief that government derives its power from the consent of the governed. Signed in 1620, it created a system grounded in cooperation and the common good.



### LIBERTY DEMANDED

## Revolutionary War Quarter

Winning independence required sacrifice. Through years, the American colonies fought to secure the liberty they had declared. This design reflects the determination of those who defended the ideals that would form the foundation of the United States.

## Declaration of Independence Quarter

The Declaration of Independence marked a defining moment in history. In its opening lines, the founders affirmed that all people possess unalienable rights, including life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. Its evolutionary spirit is echoed in this coin.



### LIBERTY DEFINED

## U.S. Constitution Quarter

The Constitution transformed the ideals of independence into a lasting framework of law and governance. Rooted in the principle that authority flows from the people, it established a system designed to protect liberty while balancing power among its institutions.

## Gettysburg Address Quarter

During the Civil War, President Abraham Lincoln called on the Nation to renew its commitment to equality and self-government. The Gettysburg Address reaffirmed that all people are created equal and challenged future generations to carry that promise forward.

Marked with the dual date 1776-2026, the Semiquincentennial nickel commemorates 250 years of American independence. It stands as a reflection on the ideals that shaped the Nation back then and continue to guide its future now.
