1. Write a proposal depicting a place that you feel should be memorialized as a symbol of conservation. Provide a detailed description of the location. Be specific and creative in your proposal.
2. The proposal needs to be one page in length and neatly written or typed and free of spelling or grammar errors. Remember, this is a proposal meant to persuade, you need to be convincing!
